following the recent communication regarding the shigellosis cases in the community. Also, if you have had a confirmed case, please contact the school immediately. Thank you

Dear Parents / Carers.

I am writing to inform you that a small number of children who attend Ravenbank Community Primary School have recently had an illness called bacterial dysentery (shigellosis).

Shigellosis is caused by shigella bacteria that infect the gut, causing diarrhoea (often watery or slimy and sometimes bloody), fever, stomach cramps and sometimes vomiting. The illness may last for only a day or continue for one to two weeks. The incubation period (the time taken from coming into contact with the bug until the illness starts) is usually 1 to 3 days but can be up to a week.

If your child is well, then you do not need to do anything at this time.

If your child currently has or does develop symptoms, please get medical attention and show this letter to the doctor. They may arrange for a stool (poo) sample to be tested for the illness and ask your child to stay away from school until at least 48 hours after their symptoms end.

People with this bug are infectious to other people while they are ill and have symptoms. Handwashing is the most important way to stop the spread of this illness. The following actions can be taken to reduce the risk of getting this bug or spreading it to others these include:

- Washing hands thoroughly with liquid soap and running water after using the toilet (or helping others
 including changing nappies) and before meals. People with false nails should pay particular attention to
 cleaning these thoroughly.
- Being very careful with hand hygiene if taking care of others who are ill (such as helping with toileting
 or changing nappies).
- Washing dirty clothes, bedding and towels on the hottest wash cycle possible and not sharing towels or face flannels with someone who is infected.

If your child currently has or develops symptoms the following actions should be taken, where relevant, to reduce the risk of spreading the infection:

- Staying away from school until at least 48 hours after the symptoms end.
- Make sure you follow any advice or recommendations you get from the Environmental Health Department and/or Health Protection Team.
- Where possible, staying away from other people until symptoms end.
- Not preparing food for others until at least 48 hours after the symptoms end.
