Where does your child sit on the pathway to good attendance?



The average attendance at Ravenbank is over 97% and this is above national averages.

100%

We understand that children can be ill from time to time. It also helps if all appointments are made outside of school hours.

98%

Having good attendance significantly improves a child's academic outcomes and personal development.

96%

95% is equivalent to 2 weeks missed schooling a year.

94%

At this stage parents/ carers will receive a letter informing you of the need to improve the child's attendance.

At this stage parents/ carers will be invited to a meeting to set some goals and strategies to improve attendance. If they do not attend or contact us to rearrange, we may contact the Local Authority for a notice to improve.

90%

90% is equivalent to 4 weeks missed schooling a year.

75%

Attendance that falls below 75% is considered a risk factor and could be considered a safeguarding concern.

This is classed as severely absent and there must be a plan in place to improve the child's attendance urgently.

50%

If your child has medical needs that affect their attendance, there should be plans in place to support their needs.
